A **creditor** is who you owe the debt to.

An **unsecured debt** is a debt not backed by an asset (e.g. a credit card, tax debt, personal loan). An **unsecured creditor** does not have the right to repossess and sell an asset if you are unable to repay what you owe them.

A **related entity** includes a relative, a company in which you or a relative are a director, a trust in which you or a relative are a beneficiary or trustee, a partnership in which you or a relative are a member.
